

AIRPORT BREMEN

Special safety requirements

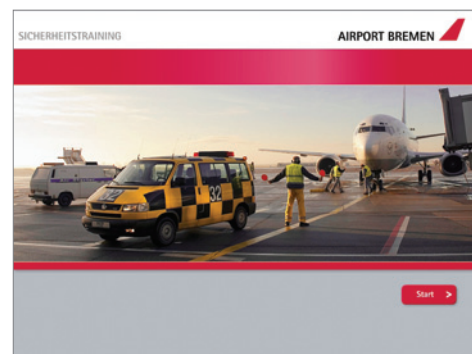
Bremen airport is the airport for the North West of Germany. A passenger volume of approx. 2.5 million annually makes it one of the Republic's major commercial airports. In addition to passenger transport, Bremen airport serves to transport wing parts which are manufactured in the adjoining Airbus plant.

Challenge

The special safety requirements of a modern commercial airport require a differentiated training process. In the past, it has been necessary to organise group training courses for various target groups and they were teacher-centred.

This required an appropriately great deal of upfront coordination and planning.

The aim was to replace this kind of teaching by a modern training system. This was to reduce the expenditure for organisation, guarantee the safety standard and ensure gapless documentation. If possible, licence fees should be a one-off expenditure.

Solution

ASIP was chosen following an in-depth exploratory phase. The system was introduced within just six weeks. The existing instruction materials were revised and integrated step by step. The process was started with the security profile (persons / luggage inspection etc.) followed by the safety profile (conventional occupational health and safety). ASIP was integrated into running operations without interruptions. Employees and executives alike judged the user-friendly teaching as good. Moreover, the system was certified by the Landesluftfahrtbehörde (the federal state aviation authority).

Conclusion

ASIP enabled the installation of a consistent training process within a very short time which improved efficiency and simplified organisation. These positive effects and the employees' approval speak in favour of a further extension of the portal. Additional instruction contents and profiles as well as a connection to the access control system will follow.
